Meeting was called to order at 7:05pm by Roy Blakely.

Present: Roy Blakely, Jason Morneau, & John Teiner. Meeting was held in person at the Park Department office (142 South Street).

Roy Blakely made a motion to accept the minutes of April 13th, 2023. Motion was seconded by Jason Morneau. Park Commissioners signed Bills FY23W46E.

John Teiner presented the Park Commissioners the FOD baseball field (Babe Ruth diamond) and Faille Field (soccer) calendars for the spring 2023 field rental youth sports organizations. Jim Marot and the facilities department will have the NEW baseball dugouts completed by May 27th for the Babe Ruth baseball field.

After-school dodgeball program has 67 children registered from kindergarten to 6th grade. Spring Rec Soccer has 153 children registered from Pre-K to 4th grade. Final day of spring rec soccer is June 3rd, 2023.

Hannah Baldwin and Linda Evans are not able to help this summer as summer rec assistants. John Teiner reached out to the town administrator for help. Sydney Freeman (part-time) town hall employee can help this summer for 20 hours as a summer rec assistant. Brenna Evans was hired as the head summer rec counselor to assist John Teiner in the office and help with the summer rec children & lead the staff.

John Teiner presented the Park Commissioners with the 2023 Summer Rec program, Swim Lessons & Town Pool flyer's, dates & costs. Summer Rec & Swim Lessons start on Monday June 26th. Town Pool cover coming off and pool install set up will take place on May 24th, 2023. Town Pool will open on Saturday June 24th, 2023.

John Teiner presented to the Park Commissioners Fillion Quote for annual Pool Filter Maintenance. Roy Blakely made a motion to accept and approve the quote. Motion was seconded by Jason Morneau.

Plainville parents reached out to John Teiner for the 6th grade graduation party at the Town Park on June 15th. John Teiner will do his best to try and get the pool inspection to pass and open the pool early for the 6th grade graduation party. Roy Blakely and Jason Morneau voted and approved the event to take place.

John Teiner will reach out to sportsman and get 2 other quotes on rec software programs before approval.

John Teiner and Park Commissioners discussed FOD phase 2 and went over top needs to present at town meeting and to the design company.

New Park Department office construction is scheduled for Sept 2023. Jim Marot will run and oversee the project by the Facilities Department.

Roy Blakely made a request to see if the Plainville Lions Club who wanted to host a circus at the Plainville Town Park for the summer of 2024 could confirm with the circus company to see if they can put terplast down so the tent and show does not completely ruin the grass. John Teiner will follow up with the Plainville Lions Club. Park Commissioners did not want to vote on approval until all 3 board members are present.
