Underground service, trench, or water well (additional fee – each)	\$50.00

Additions or alterations to existing dwellings, three or more devices, 2 inspections	\$50.00
Minimum wiring fee: (less than three devices, burglar alarm, telephone, cable TV, TV for security systems, sound system)	\$30.00
Gas or oil burners	\$50.00

Swimming pools – in-ground	\$100.00

House panel & devices connected to multifamily buildings	\$50.00
Fire alarm systems to municipal box in multifamily buildings	\$50.00
Mobile homes from pedestal or distribution box	\$100.00
Replacement of existing meter pedestals (per meter)	\$50.00
Annual maintenance permits (1 year from date of issuance) For 1 st building plus \$50.00 each additional building ***Annual log inspection required***	\$100.00 Additional fees may be required
Sign (each)	\$50.00
Minimum wire fee	\$50.00
Circus, carnival, trade show, etc.	\$200.00
Trench inspection (each)	\$50.00
Re-inspection	\$50.00
Permit renewal **	\$50.00
Solar panels (price per panel) up to 500 panels	\$5.00
501-2,000 panels	\$3.00
Over 2,000 panels	\$1.50

ALL PERMITS ARE NON-REFUNDABLE AND NON-TRANSFERABLE

* Costs shall include all labor, material and equipment

** Permits expire 1 year from issuance for new work, 6 months from issuance on remodeling

The required fee will be doubled if work is started and you do not obtain a permit within five (5) days, or if you do not have the consent of the electrical inspector. Such fee shall not affect the penalty prescribed by Mass. Electrical Code.
