MUNICIPAL TRASH & RECYCLING PROGRAM July 1, 2016 - June 30, 2017

- RECYCLING CENTER Extended summer hours The recycling center will be open on Mondays & Saturdays, 8:00 a.m. 3:00 p.m. April through November. November, December January & March hours will be Mondays 8:00 a.m. 3:00 p.m and Saturdays, 8:00 a.m. 1:00 p.m. The center is closed the month of February. Residents are reminded that you must display the green recycling center VEHICLE PLACARD with the current year sticker to access the recycling center. The license plate on the placard must match the license plate on the vehicle.
- **REMINDER -** Online payment option. Residents are encourged to use the online payment system. Please visit epay.cityhallsystems.com and follow the instructions to pay the annual fee on-line and for details on convenience fees. A link for Online Bill Payments is also on the town's website at www.plainville.ma.us.
- **REMINDER Bulky Waste/Heavy Goods FEE SCHEDULE** All mattresses (crib, twin, double, queen and king) cost \$15.00 each. Large bulky items equal to or over 4 feet in height or length cost \$5.00. This includes couches, dressers, book shelves and boxsprings, etc. Small bulky items under 4 feet in height or length cost \$2.50. See details below for Bulky Waste/Heavy Goods.

PROGRAM DETAILS

- ANNUAL FEE Participation in Plainville's Municipal Trash & Recyclables Collection Program requires payment of an annual fee in addition to the per bag sticker fee (see below). Service runs July 1st thru June 30th. Annual fees are as follows: Single family homes \$120.00, two-family homes separate driveways \$120.00 each unit, two-family homes common driveway \$180.00 and three family homes \$220.00. You MUST have the "Annual Sticker" clearly visible to the drivers on the recycling or refuse container. The sticker acts as confirmation that the fee has been paid. ANNUAL FEE INCLUDES: Weekly curbside collection of recyclables, stickered refuse bags and one stickered bulky good, one Recycling Center Pass per unit, and participation in Household Hazardous Waste Collection Day (contingent upon funding).
- **BAG STICKERS** Trash & recyclables are picked up curbside weekly. Each 30 35 gallon size bag of trash requires ONE (1) YELLOW \$1.25 trash sticker. Stickers that have been tampered with will be unacceptable. Trash cans may be used to hold bagged trash. All trash bags must have a yellow trash sticker attached to the top of each bag. Bags must not exceed 35 lbs. Items must be curbside by 7:00 a.m. on your scheduled pick up day. Stickers are available at the following locations: *Cumberland Farms, Hilltop Stop, Plainville Fuel Mart, Plainville Food Mart, Rite Aid, SLM Wines(South Street), Stop & Shop.*
- RECYCLING CONTAINERS Residents are encouraged to use a maximum 35 gallon sized container to hold their recyclables. If using a standard trash container for recyclables, the container MUST be clearly marked as a "recycling" container by placing the annual sticker on it and marking it as "Recycling" with a marker, spray paint or picking up a "Recycle" label at the Board of Health office. Recycling bins or carts are not available through the Board of Health. Residents may continue to use their recycling bins or other containers for recyclables. More than one recycling container may be used. All recyclables (paper, glass, plastic & metal cans) may be placed in the same container. Cardboard must be no larger than 2' x 2' curbside.
- HOLIDAYS There is no collection on Mondays, therefore Monday Holidays WILL NOT result in delays for the week. If New Years Day, July 4th, Thanksgiving or Christmas falls on a Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday or Friday, collection will be delayed one day following the holiday for the remainder of the week. In addition to the above holidays, the recycling center will be CLOSED on the following Monday holidays: Martin Luther King Day, Presidents Day, Memorial Day, Labor Day, and Columbus Day. NOTE: The recycling center will be open on Patriot's Day. Veteran's Day will NOT result in a refuse collection delay or the recycling center being closed.
- BULKY WASTE/HEAVY GOODS Participating residents are allowed to put out curbside, ONE bulky, non-metal item per week. Item must be curbside by 7:00 a.m. on the day of your regularly scheduled pick up day and must be easily handled by one person. Excessively heavy items will not be picked up. You do not need to schedule the pick up. Bulky items are picked up along with your trash on the regular route. All mattresses (crib, twin, double, queen and king size) will cost \$15.00 each. Large bulky items equal to or over 4 feet in height or length cost \$5.00 each. This includes couches, dressers, book shelves and boxsprings. Small bulky items under 4 feet in height or length cost \$2.50 each. Bulky items include: Household furniture, tables, couches, chairs, dressers, toilets, vanities and carpet or wood tied in bundles 4 feet long or less. The following items will NOT be picked up curbside: any metal items, hazardous materials, construction debris, leaf/yard waste, electronics, computers, TV's, tires or batteries. Bulky items are paid with orange \$2.50 trash stickers. (\$5.00 = two orange stickers) (\$15.00 = 6 orange stickers).

- RECYCLING CENTER ANNUAL PASS Residents participating in the trash & recyclables collection program who use the Recycling Center at the Highway Garage to drop off items listed below, will be required to display the green recycling center placard with the license plate number of the vehicle they wish to use. Passes are not transferable to other vehicles. Residents will receive the yearly decal to be placed on the green placard when the annual fee has been paid. The placard must be clearly DISPLAYED when entering the recycling center. Residents will still be required to pay the per item fees. Vehicle passes will be issued to each unit that has paid the annual fee. If residents wish to register additional vehicles per household, a fee of \$5.00 per additional vehicle will be required. Residents that choose to pay partial payments of 6 months will be issued a 6 month sticker pass. Only vehicles registered to Plainville residents or property owners will be allowed to use the Recycling Center. Only commercial vehicles that are registered to a non-business are allowed. No business commercial vehicles will be allowed. Per item fees apply, see details listed below for fee schedule and operating hours.
 - ** If you **DO NOT** participate in the Municipal Collection Program and would like to utilize the Recycling Center Drop off area, you will need to purchase a "Recycling Center Annual Pass" The cost of the pass per vehicle is \$25.00 for the period beginning July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017.
